FIRE CHIEF REPORT

Chief Sam McCrary reported that the fire department had three total calls for the month of July, nothing major just false fire alarms.

FINANCE REPORT

POLICE REPORT

Chief Lonnie Holder reported on the chase in Reynolds. There is no chase policy in the City of Reynolds, however this case fits the criteria to respond via chase and suspect was apprehended.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT

1. Director Scott Jones notified council that the depot roof repair has been completed.
2. Storm drain guards have been installed at the Hwy 128 / Hwy 96 intersection.
3. Several trees were removed from the right of way throughout the city.
4. The department has begun cleaning out several of the big ditches in town to help alleviate some of the flooding throughout the city.
5. City has received the LMIG check in the amount of \$27,933.53 which will go toward the CDBG stormwater project.
6. Also, Director Jones let the council know that he will apply for the playground grant.
