Hannah Sloan made a motion to use Glass Doctors to repair broken window at His & Her Salon and be paid out of Splost funds. Danny Peed seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

OTHER BUSINESS


EXECUTIVE SESSION – none
